## THE LINKS BETWEEN OSTEOPATHIC AND ALLOPATHIC MEDICINE



For several years, IOB, Bordeaux International Osteopathic Medical School has been developing academic partnerships in Europe and in the UAE with several medical universities. IOB is a higher education Institution agreed by the French Ministry of Health.

The heart of our medical education is to share knowledges and researches in many areas of medicine, specially in :

**Pediatrics (management of CMT, GERD, ENT Pathologies) infants and teenagers : conservative orthopedics treatments, scoliosis.**

**Cranio-facial pathologies (migraines, headaches, neuralgia, TMJ disorders & tinitus).**

**All spine pathologies and disorders.**



## THE EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

- Acquire the basics of a holistic diagnosis and conceptual principles in Osteopathic Medicine.
- Understand the links between Allopathic and Osteopathic Medicine in the approach and management of functionals and organics pathologies.
- Master the interdisciplinary collaboration that develops interactivity and opens up multidisciplinary research perspectives.
- The teaching of clinical research on the etiological factors of pathologies to increase the clinical examination skills: identify the etiological factors of a disease and know the anatomic and physiological links responsible for the symptoms and their chronic evolution.
- Acquire a vision and clinical reading of radiological examination.
- Acquire a clinical vision of sympathetic nervous system disorders and the autonomic nervous impacts on health and diseases.

## DAY 1 - June 28

- Morning: Welcome ceremony and lunch with IOB team
- Afternoon:
  - Theoretical course.
  - Concepts and principles of Osteopathic Medicine and interdisciplinary with Allopathic Medicine.
  - Osteopathic Medicine and neurology: the neuro-physiological foundations of Osteopathic manipulation treatments.
  - Presentation of the international protocol of somatic dysfunctions diagnosis.

## DAY 2: SPINE DAY - June 29

- Morning: How to manage and treat lumbago and acute low back pain? Clinical examination on patients and clinical course.
- Afternoon: How to manage a lumbar disc hernia with an etiological approach and conservative treatment? Clinical examination on patients and clinical course.

## DAY 3: PEDIATRIC DAY - June 30

- Morning: Clinical examination on babies and children: benefits for a newborn or child of an osteopathic clinical examination.
- Afternoon: Management and conservative treatment of torticollis, cranial assymetry and plagiocephaly.

## DAY 4: DISSECTION DAY - July 1

- Dissections of the lumbar and cervical spine at the Anatomy Laboratory of Bordeaux University of Medicine by university professors and hospital practitioners.

## DAY 5: CLINICAL DAY (AT THE IOB CLINIC) - July 2

- Radiological reading workshops: clinical reading of radiological examinations.
- Active students participation in patients consultation.
- Cases analysis workshops as part of a holistic medical concept.

## DAY 1: CRANIO-FACIAL DAY - July 5

## DAY 2: VISCERAL DAY - July 6

- Morning: Theoretical course on etiological factors of GERD, gastrites, hiatal hernia.
- Afternoon: Osteopathic clinical examination of the abdomen and management of GERD, gastrites, hiatal hernia.

## DAY 3: DISSECTION DAY - July 7

- Dissection of the skull at the Anatomy Laboratory of Bordeaux University of Medicine by university professors and hospital practitioners.

## DAY 4: PEDIATRIC DAY - ENT PATHOLOGIES - July 8

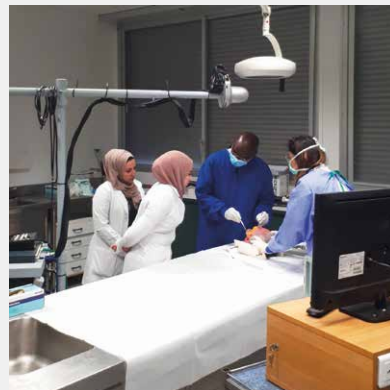
- Morning: Theoretical course on etiological factors of ENT pathologies: otitis media, serous ear infections, rhino-pharyngitis.

#### Duration of program

2 weeks



#### Dates

June 28 to July 10, 2021  
*Summer Season in France*



#### Number of students

The organization and the participation of several international lecturers require a **minimum of 10 students** and a **maximum of 20**.



#### Site for placement

The program takes place at the IOB Institution and in professional and educational clinics. The skull and spine dissections are planned in the anatomy laboratory of Bordeaux University of Medicine.

### Cost

2100 euros per student for a group of minimum 10 students  
1800 euros per student for a group of minimum 15 students  
1600 euros per student for a group of minimum 20 students

#### The cost of the program includes

- Theoretical and practical training, clinical internships : 50 hours
- Dissections: 12 hours
- Supervision, transport on the various sites by IOB driver
- Taking care of the students from their arrival until their departure
- Welcome Lunch
- Lunch Closing Ceremony
